THE TWO INFANTRY BATTALIONS DEPARTED THE MRB ABOUT 0430 IN BIVDIV 92 AND 111 BOATS FOR THE LONG TRIP UP THE SONG VAM CO DONG TO THE OPERATIONS AREA WHICH IS KNOWN AS "THE EAGLE'S BEAK."

PAGE 2 JEBI UNCLAS E F T O 3/07 INF BN AND ALFA COMPANY OF 3/60 VERE LANDED BETWEEN 1030 AND 1030 AFTER WHICH THE BOATS REMAINED IN THE AREA TO PROVIDE CLOSE SUPPORT. BRAVO AND CHARLIE COMPANIES OF 3/60 WERE BEACHED AT A PICK-UP ZONE ALONG THE SOMS VAM CO DONG FOR AIRLIFT INTO THE CENTER OF THE AO. BRAVO COMPANY WAS AIRMOBILED INTO THE AO WITHOUT INCIDENT, LANDING AT 1119. CHARLIE COMPANY WAS COMMITTED TO THE OPERATION AT 1143 BUT THEIR AIRLIFT WAS DELAYED TO EASLY AFTERNOON WHEN ONE OF THE AIRLIFT HELICOPTERS WAS SHOT DOWN.
