DAILY INTERNAL INFORMATION SUMMARY

ONLY MINOR INCIDENTS MARRED THE NEW YEAR'S TRUCE MONDAY AS BOATS OF GIV DIVS 91 AND 111 CONTINUED TO SUPPORT 3/60 AND 4/47 INFANTRY BATTALLIONS IN WESTERN DINH TUONG PROVINCE.

CHARLAY COMPANY OF THE 3/60 INFANTRY, OPERATING NORTH OF SNOOPY'S NOSE, RECEIVED SPOGADIC AUTOMATIC WEAPONS FIRE DURING THE DAY, AFTER PATICULARLY HEAVYBARRAGES AT 1300 AND 1400. FIRE WAS RETURNED BY BOTH ARMY TROOPS AND RIV DIV 91 MONITORS AND ASPB'S WITH NO KNOWN CASUALTIES ON EITHERSIDE. ADDITIONAL AUTOMATIC WEAPONS FIRE WAS RECEIVED BY CHARLIE AND ECHO COMPANIES OK 3/60 AT 1945 WITH THE ARMY REPORTING ONE MAN RECEIVING MINOG WOUNDS. THE TRUCE WAS SCHEDULED TO CONTINUE UNTIL 0600 TUESDAY.
