DAILY INTERNAL INFORMATION SUMMARY NO. 31-03

BOATS OF RIV DIVS 91, 111 AND 112 RETURNED TO THE MRS TUESDAY MORNING AFTER A FIVE-DAY OPERATION IN WESTERN DINH TUONG PROVINCE. FINAL RESULTS RECORDED BY THE 3/68 AND 4/47 INFANTRY BATTALIONS INCLUDED 5 VC KILLED IN ACTION AND 8 VC POW'S. TWELVE ARMY PERSONNEL WERE WOUNDED BY SNIPER FIRE OR BOOBY TRAPS DURING THE FIVE DAYS IN THE FIELD.

NO CASUALTIES WERE REPORTED AS A RESULT OF TUESDAY MORNING'S MORTAR ATTACK ON DONG TAM. AN ESTIMATED 15 TO 20 ROUNDS FELL IN THE NORTH-WEST SECTOR OF THE BASE, MOST OF THEM JUST NORTH OF THE AIRFIELD.

ARMY AND NAVY MEDICAL AND DENTAL PERSONNEL STAGED A MEDCAP AND DENTCAP AT THE LOCAL HAMLET OF KIM SON TUESDAY. ATC 92-7 TRANSPORTED AN ARMY DOCTOR AND NAVY DENTIST LCDR MORRISON OF APL-26 TO THE VILLAGE, WHICH IS LOCATED 5 KM UP RIVER FROM DONG TAM.
