FRIDAY WAS A READY REACTION DAY FOR MOST IF 117 UNITS.
THE ONLY ELEMENTS ACTIVE WERE BOATS OF RIV DIVS 91 AND 92
WORKING WITH 3/34 ARTILLERY AND 4/47 INFANTRY, RESPECTIVELY,
IN OPERATIONS SOUTH OF BEN TRE.

THE 92 BOATS BEACHED TWO COMPANIES OF 4/47 WITHOUT INCIDENT
FRIDAY MORNING, THEN RETURNED TO A FIRE SUPPORT BASE ON THE SONG
CO CHIEN WHERE THEY REMAINED OVERNIGHT WITH A GROUP OF 91 BOATS.

THE MRF WAS VISITED FRIDAY BY MAJOR GENERAL RICHARD F. SHAEFER,
ASSISTANT CHIEF OF STAFF FOR COMMUNICATIONS AT COMUSMACV.
