THIRTEEN VC WERE KILLED BY SECOND BRIGADE ELEMENTS FRIDAY NIGHT AND SATURDAY IN SPORADIC CONTACT SOUTH AND SOUTHEAST OF BEN TRE.

IN THE MOST FRUITFUL ENGACEMENT FRIDAY EVENING, NINE VC WERE KILLED BY ALPHA COMPANY, 4/47 INFANTRY IN LIGHT ACTION WITH SMALL VC SQUADS. THERE WERE TWO U.S. WOUNDED IN THE EXCHANGE OF FIRE.

ON SATURDAY, ELEMENTS OF 3/47 INFANTRY RECEIVED INTERMITTENT SMALL ARMS AND AUTOMATIC WEAPONS FIRE THROUGHOUT THE DAY. FOUR VC

WERE KILLED AND ONE AK-47 AND A CARBINE WERE CAPTURED.

TWO COMPANIES OF 4/47 INFANTRY WERE BACKLOADED ON THE SONG COCHIEN SOUTH OF BEN TRE BY RIV DIV 52 BOATS SATURDAY AFTERNOON FOR RETURN TO THE MRB. THE ONLY OTHER TASK GROUP ALPHA BOATS ACTIVE FAGE 2 RUMUGKKSDS4 UNCLASE FOR TO SATURDAY WERE SIX UNITS OF PIV DIV 111 WHICH ESCORTED AN ARMY LOUSAND AND TO THE SONG MY THE

FROM MY THO TO FIRE SUPPORT BASE DAVID AND BACK TO THE SONG MY THO WITHOUT INCIDENT.

BOATS OF RIV DIV 151 HAD NO RESISTANCE SATURDAY WHILE SUPPORTING

FOUR REGIONAL FORCE COMPANIES IN STARCH AND SYSTEP OPERATIONS ALONG THE SONG MANO THIT. THE FOUR COMPANIES WERE LANDED ON THE MANG THIT SATURDAY MORNING ABOUT 20 KILCHETERS SOUTH OF VINH LONG.

IN A DELAYED REPORT FROM CAN GLOUC, A COMBINED U. S.-VIETNAMESE FORCE SUPPORTED BY BOATS OF RIV DIV 132 KILLED FIVE VC AND TOOK 13 PRISONERS OF WAR DURING AN OPEHATION FRIDAY 15 KILOMETERS NORTH OF GO CONG.

GROUND UNITS INVOLVED IN THE SWEEP WERE CHARLEY COMPANY, 3/39 INFANTRY, REGIONAL FORCE/POPULAR FORCE TPOOPS AND CAN GIOUC DISTRICT NATIONAL POLICE. IN ADDITION TO THE PERSONNEL LOSSES, THE ENEMY LOST ONE AK-47, AN M-1, 4N-M-16, TWO GRENADE LAUNCHERS, TWO PISTOLS AND NUMEROUS DOCUMENTS.

REPORTS FROM TASK GROUP BRAVO INDICATED THAT MONITOR 132-2, ATC 131-1 AND ATC 132-11 WERE AMBUSHED ON THEIR WAY BACK TO CAN GIOUC FRIDAY AFTERNOON, BUT THERE WAS NO PEPORT OF U. S. CASUALTIES. ST
