THE BODY COUNT IN THE MRF'S WEEK-LONG OPERATION IN CHUNG THIEN AND KIEN GIANG PROVINCES ROSE OVER 200 MONDAY AS ARMY GUNSHIPS AND AN AIR FORCE SPOTTER PLANE KILLED 17 MORE VIET CONG.

THE 17 KIA HIKE THE 7-DAY TOTAL TO 266--THE MOST ENEMY KILLED IN A SINGLE OPERATION SINCE THE HISTORIC BATTLE OF DECEMBER 4-6 WHEN 266 VC WERE KILLED ON THE RACH RUONG CANAL.

FOURTEEN ENEMY WERE KILLED MONDAY BY THE GUNSHIPS OF 7-1 AIR CAVALRY, WHILE THE OTHER THREE WERE CLAIMED BY THE USAF FORWARD AIR CONTROLLER.

THERE WAS VIRTUALLY NO GROUND CONTACT MONDAY, ALTHOUGH ALPHA COMPANY, 3/68 INFANTRY, FOUND A SMALL ARMS AND AMMUNITION CACHE IN THE AFTERNOON WHICH INCLUDED SIX CARBINES, ONE GREASE GUN

AND A MACHINE GUN.

BOTH THE VIETNAMESE MARINES AND 3/68 INFANTRY STAYED IN THE FIELD OVERNIGHT AS 4/47 INFANTRY REMAINED AT THE MRF FORWARD BASE AT VI THANH. BOATS OF RIVER DIVISIONS 92, 111, AND 112 SPENT THE DAY ANCHORED IN THE CAI LOU RIVER NEAR FIRE SUPPORT BASE WINCHESTER.
