TWO VIET CONG WERE KILLED SUNDAY AS MRF ELEMENTS EXPERIENCED ONLY LIGHT RESISTANCE WHILE OPERATING WEST OF THE CROSSROADS ON THE LA LAI RIVER.

CONTACT WAS LIMITED TO SEVERAL EXCHANGES OF SMALL ARMS AND AUTOMATIC WEAPONS FIRE LATE IN THE MORNING. FIVE OTHER VIETNAMESE WERE DETAINED AND 59 BUNKERS WERE DESTROYED DURING THE DAY.

THE TROOPS OF 4/47 INFANTRY WERE LANDED ALONG THE SONG BA LAI ABOUT 0725 BY BOATS OF RIVER DIVISION 111. ELEMENTS OF 3/60 INFANTRY WERE AIRLIFTED INTO THE OPERATION AREA TO POSITIONS SOUTH OF THE 4/47 BEACHES.

MOST OF THE ASSAULT BOATS RETURNED TO THE MRB SUNDAY EVENING, ALTHOUGH SEVERAL UNITS OF DIVISIONS 92, 111 AND 112 REMAINED AT A FIRE SUPPORT BASE JUST NORTH OF THE CROSSROADS FOR COMMAND AND CONTROL PURPOSES.

THE MRB RELOCATED TO THE ANCHORAGE EAST OF MY THO SUNDAY MORNING, DEPARTING DONG TAM AT 0700Z AND CLOSING THE NEW LOCATION AT 0802Z.
