SEARCH AND DESTROY OPERATIONS NORTHEAST OF CAI BE WERE  
TERMINATED ABOUT NOON TUESDAY, WITH NEITHER ARMY NOR NAVY ELEMENTS  
REPORTING ANY CONTACT.

ALL BOATS AND THEIR EMBARKED TROOPS CLOSED THE MRB BY 1700.  
FINAL RESULTS OF THE TWO-DAY OPERATION WERE TWO VC KILLED BY  
GUNSHIPS AND FOUR OTHERS CAPTURED BY 3/60 INFANTRY.

FRIENDLY CASUALTIES WERE ONE KILLED AND 27 WOUNDED, INCLUDING  
SIX FROM NON-HOSTILE ACTION. THE FATALITY AND 17 OF THE WOUNDED WERE  
NAVYMEN INVOLVED IN MONDAYS SERIES OF SIX ENEMY ATTACKS ON THE ASSAULT  
BOATS OPERATING ON THE CAI BE AND BA RAI RIVERS.

THE MRB RELOCATED FROM VINH LONG TO THE DONG TAM ANCHORAGE  
TUESDAY AFTERNOON, WITH THE FINAL SHIPS ANCHORING AT 1510.

LT GEN HENRY W.O. KENNARD, CG U.S. ARMY COMBAT DEVELOPMENTS  
COMMAND, VISITED THE MRF THIS AFTERNOON. HE WAS BRIEFED ABOUT OUR  
OPERATIONS, VISITED THE BOATS, AND TOOK A RIDE IN A PACV. HE WAS VERY  
INTERESTED IN ALL OF OUR OPERATIONS.
