SIXTEEN MORE VC WERE KILLED BY TASK GROUP ALPHA ELEMENTS
 MONDAY IN LIGHT, SPORADIC CONTACT ALONG THE HAI MUOI TAM CANAL
 NORTHWEST OF CAI BE.

EIGHT OF THE ENEMY WERE KILLED BY AIR FORCE PLANES, SIX WERE
 CLAIMED BY 3/60 INFANTRY AND TWO WERE CREDITED TO THE ASSAULT CRAFT.
 ARMY ELEMENTS IN CONTACT WITH AN ESTIMATED MAIN FORCE BATTALION
 SUNDAY NIGHT REPORTED THAT THE ENEMY SLIPPED AWAY AFTER DARKNESS, AND
 A SWEEP OF THE HEAVILY BOMBED ENEMY POSITIONS THURSDAY YIELDED ONLY
 A FEW BODIES, FIVE WEAPONS AND A SMALL AMOUNT OF AMMUNITION.

THE 3/60 INFANTRY REMAINED IN THE AO MONDAY NIGHT, BUT 4/47

 INFANTRY WAS BACKLOADED IN THE AFTERNOON BY BOATS OF RIVER DIVISION
 112 AND ALL UNITS CLOSED THE MRB ABOUT 2000.

FOUR ARMY PERSONNEL WERE KILLED MONDAY AFTERNOON IN THE CRASH
 OF A "PEOPLE-SNIFFER" HELICOPTER. THE PILOT AND CO-PILOT BOTH
 SURVIVED THE CRASH AND WERE EVACUATED TO DONG TAM, BUT THE
 CREW CHIEF, A DOOR GUNNER AND BOTH PERSONNEL MANNING THE ELECTRONICS
 EQUIPMENT WERE KILLED. THE ONLY OTHER FRIENDLY CASUALTIES OF
 THE DAY WERE FOUR INFANTRYMEN WOUNDED BY BOOBY TRAPS AND SNIPER
 FIRE.
