DAILY INTERNAL INFO SUMMARY 03-21

A QUIET DAY WAS REPORTED WEDNESDAY BY TWO MRF BATTALIONS
ENGAGED IN SEARCH AND DESTROY OPERATIONS ABOUT TWO MILES NORTH
OF MY THO.

TWO VIET CONG WERE KILLED BY ARTILLERY FIRE AND ONE WAS
WOUNDED BY 4/47 INFANTRY DURING THE DAY. FRIENDLY CASUALTIES
WERE THREE ARMY PERSONNEL WOUNDED, INCLUDING TWO FROM NON-HOSTILE
ACTS.

ALL TROOPS WERE AIRLIFTED INTO THE AO BY HELICOPTER WEDNESDAY
MORNING AFTER THEY WERE TRANSPORTED TO PICKUP ZONES BY BOATS OF
SQUADRON NINE. THE ONLY NAVY ELEMENTS INVOLVED IN THE ACTUAL
OPERATION ARE SEVEN BOATS STATIONED NEAR MY THO WHICH ARE PROVIDING
COMMAND AND CONTROL FACILITIES AND ARE ACTING AS AN AFLOAT MEDICAL

STATION.

A BOOBY TRAP ON THE NORTH BANK OPPOSITE THE MRF RESULTED IN
THE DEATH OF ONE INFANTRYMAN AND INJURIES TO FOUR OTHERS WEDNESDAY
NIGHT. A DAISY-CHAIN TRIP WIRE TOUCHED OFF TWO OR THREE GRENADES
AS ELEMENTS OF CHARLEY COMPANY OF 4/47 INFANTRY WERE ESTABLISHING
FIGHT POSITIONS.

SHIPS OF THE MRB AND ASSAULT CRAFT CONDUCTED H AND I FIRES
ON THE SOUTH BANK WEDNESDAY NIGHT AFTER A REPORT OF VC ACTIVITY
IN THE AREA. AN AUTHORITATIVE INTELLIGENCE SOURCE INDICATED
THAT A VC FORCE OF UNKNOWN SIZE WAS PREPARING TO AMBUSH THE MRB
WITH B-40 ROCKETS. THE BENEWAH, WASHTENAW COUNTY AND TWO ASP'S
CONTINUED THE H AND I FIRE THURSDAY EVENING.
