DAILY INTERNAL INFO SUMMARY 25-21

ALL ELEMENTS OF THE MPF WERE ON A MAXIMUM ALERT STATUS WEDNESDAY IN THE FACE OF A WIDE OUTBREAK OF ENEMY ATTACKS WHICH IS INTERPRETED AS THE BEGINNING OF THE LONG PREDICTED THIRD OFFENSIVE.

MORE THAN 50 COORDINATED ATTACKS WERE LAUNCHED EARLY WEDNESDAY MORNING AGAINST IV CORPS CITIES, TOWNS, AIRFIELDS AND MILITARY INSTALLATIONS. DONG TAN RECEIVED A TOTAL OF 44 MORTAR ROUNDS IN TWO PRE-DAWN INCIDENTS AND FIVE MORE AT 1120 IN AN UNUSUAL DAYLIGHT ATTACK. THERE WERE NO CASUALTIES AND NO SIGNIFICANT DAMAGE AS A RESULT OF THE THREE MORTARINGS.
