THE TWO BATTALIONS WERE LANDED BY ASSAULT CRAFT OF RIVER DIVISIONS 91 AND 111 BETWEEN 0753 AND 2820. AFTER THE INSERTION, THE BOATS RETURNED TO A FIRE SUPPORT BASE AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE SONG VAM CO AND THE SONG TRA, WHERE THEY SPENT THE REMAINDER OF THE DAY. DURING THE NIGHT, 13 BOATS FROM THE TWO SQUADRONS CONDUCTED PATROLS
