GROUND FORCES HAD ANOTHER QUIET DAY MONDAY IN OPERATIONS IN THE BAN LONG DISTRICT OF DINH TUONG PROVINCE.

ONE BURST OF ENEMY AUTOMATIC WEAPONS FIRE WAS THE SUM TOTAL OF HOSTILE CONTACT, ALTHOUGH THERE WERE SEVERAL SIGHTINGS OF SMALL GROUPS OF SUSPECTED VC.

THE TWO U. S. ARMY BATTALIONS REMAINED IN THE AO MONDAY NIGHT, WHILE THE VIETNAMESE MARINES WERE BACKLOADED AND RETURNED TO DONG TAM AT 1530 BY BOATS OF RIVER DIVISION 111. THE ONLY CASUALTY OF THE DAY WAS A MARINE WHO STEPPED IN A PUNJI PIT.

THE 4/47 INFANTRY BATTALION AND BOATS OF RIVER DIVISION 91 CONTINUED OPERATIONS 7 KILOMETERS NORTHWEST OF THE MRB ALONG THE SONG SAM GIANG. THE THREE COMPANIES OF 3/47 WERE BACKLOADED NORTH

OF THE FIRE SUPPORT BASE AT 0800 AND WERE REINSERTED AT 0930 ON THE RACH TRA TAN 8 KILOMETERS SOUTH OF CAI LAY. FROM THAT POINT, THEY COMMENCED MOVING NORTH TOWARD ROUTE FOUR.

THE TWO ARMY BATTALIONS DETAINED FIVE VIETNAMESE AND DESTROYED 189 BUNKERS DURING THEIR SWEEPS.
