DAILY INTERNAL INFORMATION SUMMARY 11-07

TWO VC WERE KILLED THURSDAY, ONE EACH BY THE 3/60 INFANTRY BATTALION AND THE VIETNAMESE MARINE CORPS. THREE SUSPECTS WERE ALSO DETAINED. TWENTY ENEMY STRUCTURES WERE DESTROYED BY AIR FORCE UNITS.

EARLY THURSDAY MORNING, AT APPROXIMATELY 0024, THE FIELD HEAD-QUARTERS FOR THE US ARMY'S 3/47 INFANTRY BATTALION RECEIVED NINE ROUNDS OF 60 MM MORTAR FIRE, IN THE EASTERN SECTION OF KIEN HOA PROVINCE. NO MATERIAL OR PERSONNEL CASUALTIES WERE REPORTED, HOW-EVER.

DURING THE PERIOD 3 NOV TO 6 NOVEMBER, MEDCAPS WERE CON-DUCTED DAILY IN VARIOUS VILLAGES ALONG THE CHO GAO CANAL, WHILE ELEMENTS OF R IVD IV 151 CONDUCTED SALVAGE OPERATIONS IN THE
