DAILY INTERNAL INFORMATION SUMMARY - 11-29

SEVEN VIET CONG WERE KILLED BY ALFA GROUP RIVERINE FORCES ON FRIDAY, 29 NOVEMBER. THE 3/34 ARTILLERY BATTALION WAS CREDITED WITH 5 OF THESE DURING A HARASSMENT AND INTERDICTION MISSION APPROXIMATELY 4 KILOMETERS NW OF BEN TRE.

AIR ACTION ACCOUNTED FOR 2 VC KIA'S AND THE DESTRUCTION OF 6 ENEMY STRUCTURES.

IN GROUP BRAVO ACTIVITY ON 27 NOVEMBER, SEAWOLVES PROVIDED SPOTTING ASSISTANCE FOR THE USS HUNTERDON COUNTY, WHICH SUPPORTED RIVERINE ARMED RECONNAISSANCE ELEMENTS ALONG THE KINH PHU HUU AND KINH SANG.

ARVN GROUND FORCES CONTINUED SWEEP OPERATIONS SOUTHEASTWARD ON THE DUNG ISLAND COMPLEX, AND LIBERATED 2 GVN PERSONNEL, CAP-
