USS COLLECTOR (a 3-36) 1968 BASIC MARRITIVE

The USS COLLETC: (APR-36) a solf propolled Burracks ship, was built at Joston Bayy yard, secton Mascachusetts. Ler keel was 1: id on 9 June 1945, and she was first 1 unched on 30 July, but she was not completed until September of that same year.

After twenty two years of deactivation she was touch to the Philadelphia havel Ship Yard and within five menths was specifically designed and extensively remodeled to serve the needs of the United States Army as a Command Control Center as well as a floating home, and was commissioned on 26 January 1967.

The COLLETO. is 320 feet long with a 50-feet coam. Unlike a rejerity of May Ships she has a shallow dreft of only 12-feet which gives her the crucial meneuverability needs for navigating the shillow rivers, streams, and comple that interlace the Mekong Delta.

Since the time of here arrival in Vietnam June of 1967 CULL_TOL has been operating with the Hobile Riverine Force in the Hokong Delta; River Assault Flotilla One.

The primary combat units of the ILL are the 2nd and Ord Originals of the U.S. Army's 9th Infuntry Division and eight squadrons of River Assault Boats which at different times have been emborized aboard the COLLEGO...

The COLLETON received a new Common ding Officer on 22 February 1968 when LCDR MALLUSON relieved LCDR MALBURY.

During the year COLLETOL conducted many and varied operations throughout the Bolta which required man, trensits to Bon tre, by Thos Vinh Long, Can Thos and Dong Tam meeting the innediate needs of the army.

Also COLLETON, along with the Hobilo Riverine Force, was doing her part by firing many rounds of harrasement and interdiction fire on the south bank opposite of Dong Tam to thwart the Vist Cong Communist aggressors.

12 June Commodore R.S. SALZER, USii, CTG 117 come abourd along with Army elements and held brief on Riverine Operations.

COLLENG! continued with these operations until 15 October when we left for Sasobo, Japan for a much needed yard and upkeep period. Arriving in Sasobo 25 October, and into dry dock number one on the 29th of that same month.

On the 23rd of November finished yard period and were underway for the "Delta" however a casualty in number two boiler required us to make a step at Subic Bay, Republic of Phillipines. llaving completed repairs COLLETON was underway again on 14 December 1968 to the Mokong Dolta, Ropublic of Vietname

On 16 December 1968 COLLETCH rejoined Nobile Riverine Force at My Tho, to resume combut operations. Normal Riverine Assault Operations proceded until the end of 1966 having embarked "Alfa" and "Brave" Companies of the 4th Battalian 47th Infantry.
