The **Mobile Riverine Force Association** has signed an agreement with **Arballo Entertainment** to develop and produce a documentary of the Mobile Riverine Force, Vietnam. This is the same production company that produced the *Telly Award* winning documentary movie "Scramble the Seawolves". To date there has been no production that has fully explained the Mobile Riverine Force's contribution to the Vietnam War. The unique Army and Navy unit was established to fulfill a mission in the Mekong Delta that otherwise could not have been made. The Army and Navy individually trained for this mission in Kansas and California. Our story began there and ended in the hot, humid rivers and rice paddies of Vietnam. We transited the small canals and rivers that were the traffic way for the enemy forces and inserted troops who fought their way through muddy fields and jungle.

We want to tell YOUR story! To that end, **Arballo Entertainment** will be reaching out to YOU to obtain your story! They will accept your photos, film footage, audio tapes and utilize key material for the documentary. They will begin with the formation of Task Force 117 and end with Task Force 194. Many of you may not be familiar with TF-194, but it was the very last units of the Navy, who served as a combined Naval unit, interdicting, and blocking the enemy forces entering South Vietnam from Cambodia. This includes the joint incursion into Cambodia in May 1970.

This production will not be inexpensive, nor a fast process. It will take a couple years to fully develop our story and properly produce it. This is YOUR history! To aid in the expense of this undertaking, we are asking for special donations from our membership to fund the project. There are four levels of participation. Bronze, Silver, Gold, and Platinum. If you have reels of film, please tape your name to any canister you send to us. We will convert the film digitally, make you a copy of the disc so you have it forever and we will send it back to you.

If you have a memory stick/thumb drive, please put your name (first and last) on the stick with a marker or a tag through the keychain link.

You can then take them and drag and drop into frame.io or send us the thumb drive.
