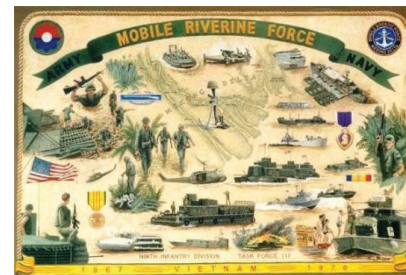

## Our Legacy Is Secure!

The men of the Mobile Riverine Force and the 9th Infantry Division, along with our associated units, have a great deal to be thankful for as we move deeper into our “*Golden Years*.”

It wasn't that long ago that two major obstacles stood in the way of our legacy. First, we faced the widespread smears against everyone who served in Vietnam. Hollywood and the press were quick to brand us all as “*baby killers*” or “*crazy Vietnam vets*.” Though that toxic perception has faded and the public now holds a far healthier appreciation for our service, the battle was real.

The second challenge was even more frustrating: virtually no one knew what the *Mobile Riverine Force* was—or how different and brutal our fight in the Mekong Delta had been. We remained largely unrecognized by friends, family, the press, and even much of the military.

Things have changed. And we owe that transformation to ourselves. Bound together by an indomitable spirit of brotherhood and pride, the members of the MRFA have built a legacy we can all stand tall in. Because of our efforts, our children's children—and their children's children—will know our true story, told by us, exactly as it happened.

These thoughts are inspired first and foremost by the powerful documentary *The Mobile Riverine Force*, produced by **Jeff and Shannon Arballo of Arballo Entertainment**. Jeff and Shannon interviewed over 70 men of the MRF and 9th Infantry Division! Yet our story extends far beyond that film. For more than thirty years, all of us have worked tirelessly—in our own ways and through our own pieces of history—to ensure the full mosaic of the Mobile Riverine Force is preserved forever.

**Tom Nielsen**, a great artist, gave us a stunning panoramic poster depicting all

the various components of the MRF. Tom also designed the Vietnam Combat Craft Crewman insignia.

Many of our sailors and soldiers were interviewed by **Michael Croan** for the **Vietnam Veterans Memorial Fund** podcast, *Echoes of the Vietnam War*.

*Mekong Mud Dogs*, by SGT **Ed Eaton**, tells the raw story of Bravo Company, 3rd Battalion, 60th Infantry.

*The Crossroads Diaries: A 19-Year-Old's Vietnam Journey*, by SSG **Tom Center** (USA Ret.), Coxswain – T-91-4, powerfully recounts the bloody firefight at “*The Crossroads*.”

*The Lionheads*, by **Major General Josiah Bunting III** (Ret.), 2nd Brigade, 9th Infantry Division.

*The Siren's Call and Second Chances: A Story of Perseverance, Service, Heroic Courage and Love*, by **Tom and Joan Kelley**. Tom nearly died saving his men in combat and lost an eye in the process. He was awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor for his heroism—yet still had to fight to remain in the Navy. Joan overcame childhood insecurities to forge her own Navy career while raising a family. In a remarkable twist of fate, these two warriors found each other and became soulmates.

*Witness to War*: Several of our members were interviewed in depth by **Martin Madert** of the *Witness to War* organization during our 2013 reunion. His powerful interviews with both Army and Navy veterans remain treasures.

*Vietnam Studies: Riverine Operations, 1966–1969*, by **Major General William B. Fulton**, Department of the Army,

1985. This official monograph details U.S. Army riverine planning and operations in Vietnam, drawing heavily on the author's own early experiences.

*Muddy Jungle Rivers*, by **Wendell Affield**. This gripping account offers a close-up look at life aboard an armored troop carrier (ATC) in 1968—the bloodiest year of the war—through the eyes of a twenty-year-old coxswain.

*The Boys of '67: Charlie Company's War in Vietnam*, by **Andrew Wiest**. While most Vietnam soldiers arrived as individual replacements, Charlie Company trained, deployed, and fought together as a true family of draftees.

*River Rats*, by **Ralph Christopher**. This Brown Water Navy story centers on 1970 and the Cambodian Incursion, following the sailors of YRBM 21 on the Mekong River and the men of River Assault Squadrons 13 and 15.

These are only a few of the many books, artworks, and personal accounts that tell the true story of the Mobile Riverine Force. You can discover dozens more at <https://www.mrfa.org/art-books-and-articles/>. We strongly encourage every veteran, spouse, and family member to explore this rich library of art, poetry, books, and memories. It is an invaluable resource for those who want to understand what their loved one experienced. These works are treasures for historians, teachers, and students alike—a lasting vault of knowledge and honor from the rice paddies, jungles, and rivers of the “*River of Nine Dragons*.”

## Memorial Day 2026

One hundred and fifty-nine years ago, in the spring of 1868, General John A. Logan called upon a still-divided nation to pause and honor its fallen. What began as Decoration Day—simple bouquets placed on fresh graves—grew into our solemn and grateful Memorial Day. For 159 Memorial Days, America has kept this promise: to remember those who answered the call, stood in the breach, and never came home.

For us in the Mobile Riverine Force, that promise carries special weight. We remember the young sailors and soldiers whose names are etched on our Fallen Brothers rolls who gave their last full measure in the muddy waters and rice paddies of the Mekong Delta. We also turn with quiet respect to the “TAPS” pages, where the names of our brothers who fought their final battle after coming home continue to be added each year. Every one of them—whether lost in combat or in the decades since—remains part of the unbreakable Riverine family.

This Memorial Day we do not gather only in sorrow. We stand taller because of them. Their courage became our standard. Their sacrifice became our bond. Their spirit still rides with every Riverine who wears the MRFA patch today. So let us decorate their memory not just with flowers, but with lives lived in honor of what they stood for—duty, loyalty, and love of country.

To all our Fallen and to every shipmate and soldier now on eternal patrol: Fair winds and following seas. You are gone, but never forgotten. We carry your legacy with pride.

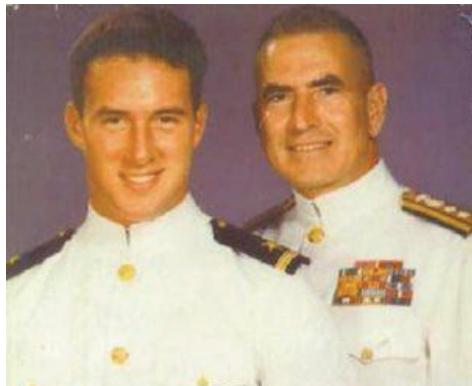
We remember our brothers who gave their lives in Vietnam. We remember the 2,624 soldiers of the 9th Infantry Division, and the 178 sailors of the Navy's ships and boats. The relatively smaller number of navy casualties is misleading. The Navy force was small by comparison, but suffered many casualties for its size. **Admiral Elmo Zumwalt Jr.** once spoke on this topic (from a 1984 PBS NewsHour interview):

*“You must remember that we were watching the defoliation take place at a time when, in my case, for example, my sailors were taking casualties at the rate of 6% per month, so that, on the average, my sailors and officers had about three-quarters of a — about a 75 percent probability of being a casualty during their year there. Anything that could be done to reduce the fearsome casualties that we were taking was an intelligent thing to do.”*

Zumwalt stood by the decision for the rest of his life, even after his own son (Elmo Zumwalt III), who served as the captain of a Swift Boat in the Mekong Delta, was diagnosed with cancer linked to Agent Orange exposure. In the book *My Father, My Son*, he wrote that he would make the same call again to save the lives of the sailors under his command.

Memorial Day 2026 falls on Monday, May 25, marking the last Monday in May. In Washington D.C., festivities coincide with America’s 250th anniversary, featuring the Freedom 250 National Memorial Day Parade on Constitution Avenue at 10 a.m. and the National Memorial Day Concert at the U.S. Capitol.

## KEY MEMORIAL DAY TRADITIONS

**Rolling to Remember:** A patriotic concert and honor ride taking place on May 24, 2026, to salute active-duty military and veterans.

**Rolling Thunder:** A motorcycle demonstration honoring POW/MIA service members, with riders rallying at the Pentagon and riding through the National Mall from May 23–25, 2026.

**National Moment of Remembrance:** A one-minute pause observed at 3:00 PM local time across the United States to reflect on the sacrifices of fallen service members.

**Flag Protocols:** The U.S. flag is raised quickly to the top of flagpoles, lowered to half-mast, and then raised again to full height at noon to symbolize the resolve of the living.

**National Parades:** Thousands of parades occur nationwide, with the National Memorial Day Parade in D.C. serving as the largest remembrance event, featuring over 5,000 participants including military units, bands, and Gold Star families.

Memorial Day calls us first to honor those who made the ultimate sacrifice in battle—an honor we will never forget. But it is also a sacred time to remember the Brothers we have loved and lost in the years since.

In that spirit, I offer this list of our fellow Mobile Riverine Force veterans whose names have been engraved forever in our hearts, in the pages of *River Currents*, and on our website, [mrfa.org](http://mrfa.org).

I do not share these names to bring sorrow or pain. I share them so our hearts may swell with pride and gratitude. These are the men who stood beside us in the Mekong Delta. They lived with courage, served with honor, and now rest in eternal peace. Their names remind us of the unbreakable bond we share—the brotherhood that time and distance can never erase.

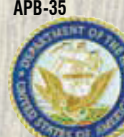

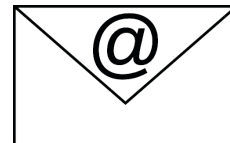
